2020 Tactical Guidelines**

Points of Emphasis CO

- Value of the (FUR) Follow up Report:
 - 360 complete
 - Life safety addressed
 - No hazards, basements
 - Confirm fire location
 - Mode
- Once BC becomes IC, scene becomes Command driven.
- Eliminate good news reporting, does not include benchmarks. Don't give updates unless asked for a Progress Report. If you're assigned to a Group or Division, your air traffic is directly with them, not the IC.

Points of Emphasis BC

- Divisions and Groups – Progress Reports (TLO).
- Decrease the amount of good news reporting.
- Stay out of the weeds of Divisions and Groups (Example: *You'll report to Division 2 and will be Back-up*).
- Recognize the emergency scene communication & benchmarks needs and find appropriate time to transmit comms to NORCOM.

Confirmation: Confirm fire location / Extension / Exposures

Mode: *Offensive Side* _____ / *Defensive* / *Rescue*

Exclusion zones: Identify location if hazards are present

360 Highlights

Homeowner states “Everyone is out of the trailer.” There is a propane tank on Bravo. Charlie looks just like Alpha

FUR Example

360 Complete

- Life Safety: *Reported trailer is evacuated*
- Hazards: *Propane tank on Bravo*
- Confirmation: *Confirmed bedroom fire self venting Alpha*
- Mode: *Offensive Alpha*



360 Highlights

Homeowner states “Everyone is out of the building.”

No basement or other hazards.

Charlie has fire venting from kitchen area extending to attic.

Wife states “husband ran into house to get the dog, has not returned.”

No basement or other hazards.

Charlie has smoke venting from gable end floor 2.

No one greets you on arrival, its 6:30 pm on a Saturday.

Home has a daylight basement.

Charlie has smoke venting from the back door that is open.

No one greets you on arrival, its 6:30 pm on Friday the 13th.

No basement, high winds and power is out.

Charlie has a home generator that is on fire and extended into the attic.

Homeowner states “She lives alone and heard a loud pop upstairs and the house started filling up with smoke.”

Home has a basement.

Charlie looks just like Alpha.

Teenage kid states “he was working on his Mustang in the garage and it caught fire, he could not put it out. Grandma lives in the basement”

Home has a basement.

Charlie shows smoke in kitchen area and venting from eaves.

Grandma is outside coughing, basement is clear.

No basement, you notice a 5-gallon gas can in the bushes on Alpha.

Charlie is clear.

Wife states “husband was barbequing on the porch, he left for the liquor store 10 minutes ago.”

Home has a basement, large propane tank on Delta.
Charlie has smoke from eaves, interior has light smoke.

- Life Safety
- Hazards
- Confirmation
- Mode





360 Highlights

Husband states “Everyone is out, fire started in garage.”

Home does not have a basement.

Charlie has heavy smoke from eyes, interior has smoke venting from open slider. Flames visible in kitchen.

360 Highlights

Apartment manager states he heard shots fired, history of domestic violence in fire unit. Unknown if everyone is out.

Three story multi-family.

Charlie has heavy smoke from fire unit, two people on balcony floor 3 filming fire with a cell phone.

360 Highlights

No one meets you on arrival.

Powerline down on driveway Delta.

Charlie has smoke from storage units opposite of fire.
